**Readers Choice Awards: 1st Prize \$1,000 2nd Prize \$500**

- All work submitted must be original and not infringe the copyright or other intellectual property rights of any other person. The festival committee reserves the right to reproduce free of charge, images of all entries for promotional or archival purposes.
- The theme for the contest is “The Rotorua Experience.”
- Applications close Friday October 7, 2017. Finalists will be notified by Friday October 20, 2017 and will have until Friday October 27, 2017 to confirm their entry.
- Undercoated power boxes will be assigned to the successful artists, and Resene Lumberside low sheen acrylic paint in black, white and primary colours will be supplied to each artist. Only this Resene paint may be used.
- Artists are required to bring their own brushes but easels, water buckets and paint containers will be supplied.
- Minor changes to the submitted design will be allowed but the finished power box design must bear a fair resemblance to the original and final approval of completion will be given by Unison.
- Artists are required to complete the power box painting by Friday December 8 2017.
- More than one artist may work on a power box but only one prize will be awarded and the contribution of each artist will be deemed equal and shared.
- All power boxes remain the property of Unison, and any changes to requirements in terms of design or health and safety will be deemed as understood by the artist.
- Finalists are expected to attend the awards ceremony on the Friday December 15 at 2pm unless other arrangements have been agreed.
- A success fee/stipend of \$400.00 (one-sided) or \$800.00 (two-sided) will be paid to each selected artist upon completion of their power box to compensate them for their travel expenses and time.
- Transport to and from the power box site is the responsibility of the artist
- Lunch and other refreshments are the responsibility of the artist.
- If selected as a successful artist, should you become unable to complete your designated power box within the specified time please notify the organisers as soon as possible.

DECLARATION: Submission of an entry into the contest automatically constitutes the artist's acceptance of all competition terms and conditions.
