



Call for Proposals

Rotorua Lakes Council is calling for proposals from local artists interested in fabricating or supplying a sculpture for the city's public art collection.

A number of pieces will be selected for permanent inclusion in the Sulphur Lake Sculpture Trail, Government Gardens. This is a tranquil and picturesque environment, which is well-enjoyed by locals, domestic and overseas visitors.

Brief:

Artworks should reflect the unique natural and cultural environment of Rotorua.

Considerations:

- Works should be scaled to suit placement and/or fixing on existing 1150mm x 1150mm concrete plinths.
- This is a high-profile, well patronized area, so it is important that public safety is considered within the design elements - scalability, protrusions, sharp edges etc
- The proposed artwork should be of a dimension and genre to suit the site and surrounding elements.
- All mediums (stone, steel, wood etc) are welcomed, provided the final artwork has structural integrity and longevity.

Proposals:

- Proposals may be in sketch, digital graphic, or marquette (miniature) format.
- Description of intended materials, dimensions and costs
- Any specific delivery or installation requirements
- Title and narrative
- Should be accompanied with a short CV and relevant folio examples

Time frames:

Closure for submissions: 5pm, Monday 10 October, 2022

Final Selection: 5pm Friday 14 October, 2022

Delivery of work/installation: Due February, 2023

Budget per sculpture Approx. \$15,000 - \$20,000
